

## Holiday Checklist

Print out this list to help you with your arrangements and packing. This list is not exhaustive but should get you started!

### General Items



- Passports**
- Flight tickets
- Hire car vouchers/details
- Driving Licences
- Travel Insurance documents (including E111)
- Cash (local currency and Euros)
- Credit Cards (you *may* need your PIN for 'Chip & Pin' transactions) [i](#)
- Traveller's cheques (take a note of reference numbers and keep separate from the cheques themselves)
- Medication/Doctors note
- Travel sickness remedies
- Glasses / Contact lens and solutions
- Camera
- Sunglasses
- Camcorder
- Pen and paper
- Books/magazine for the plane
- Flight socks
- Games for the flight
- Penknife (pack in suitcase)
- We would suggest that you take photocopies of all important documents such as your passport, driving licence, etc and keep them separate from the originals.
- Mobile phone - check you can use international roaming and your tariff! Take your charger if you don't trust your battery for length of stay
- Pocket torch
- Toiletries (tweezers, scissors and razors **MUST** go in suitcase)
  
- Toothpaste

- Toothbrush
- Soap
- Brush / Comb (there is a hairdryer in the apartment)
- Make up
- Deodorant
- Shampoo / Conditioner
- Aftershave / Perfume
- Shaving kit
- Cleanser / Toner
  
- Plug travel adaptors
- Sun creams and sun blocks
- Swimwear
- Beach towels (the apartment does not have beach towels)
- Cap / Hat
- Shorts
- T-shirts / evening shirts / blouses
- Underwear
- Other clothes
- Sandals and trainers
- Other shoes
- Lightweight jacket or jumper for the evenings (a fleece is ideal)
- Socks / Handkerchiefs
- Jewellery
- Books (there is a selection in the apartment for your use)
- Personal CD/MiniDisc/MP3 player (batteries / charger?)
- Personal dietary requirements (gluten free etc)
- First aid kit/vitamins/stomach upset, hangover remedies

### **Home Checklist**

- Ensure your pets are looked after for the duration of your holiday
- Cancel newspapers and milk
- Activate your alarm
- Leave a key with someone you can trust
- Tell your neighbours you are going on holiday and to keep an eye out for you
- Make sure anyone you give keys to knows how to work your alarm
- Lock all doors and windows
- Ask you neighbour/friend to remove your post and free newspapers regularly
- Unplug all electrical appliances, except your freezer
- Ensure your vehicles are safely parked and locked
- Activate any timer switches on lighting

- Leave a contact number with a responsible person in the event of emergencies
